


COUNTRYSIDE MARQUEE...



Devon has around 39 resident butterfly species and we can help point you in the right direction regarding where and when is best to see them.



Work at Shaldon Wildlife Trust is vital to the long-term survival of many animals which are at risk of

extinction in their natural habitat. None of our animals have been taken from the wild; the majority were born in our zoo or come from other collections taking part in specific breeding programmes to ensure their survival.

Hedgehogs are in serious decline and are now officially vulnerable to extinction. Prickles in a Pickle is a home-based Wildlife Sanctuary which has become busier and busier over the years, especially with sick hedgehogs. The hedgehog rescue & wildlife sanctuary is located in south Dartmouth, Devon. As a Registered Charity they rely on donations to provide essential care for the rehabilitation and safe release of Hedgehogs.



The Woodside Animal Welfare Trust is an animal rehoming charity as well as a large and vital safety net for vulnerable animals. The sponsorship of a dog kennel, cat pod or rabbit pen helps to support the animals short term in our homing blocks.
