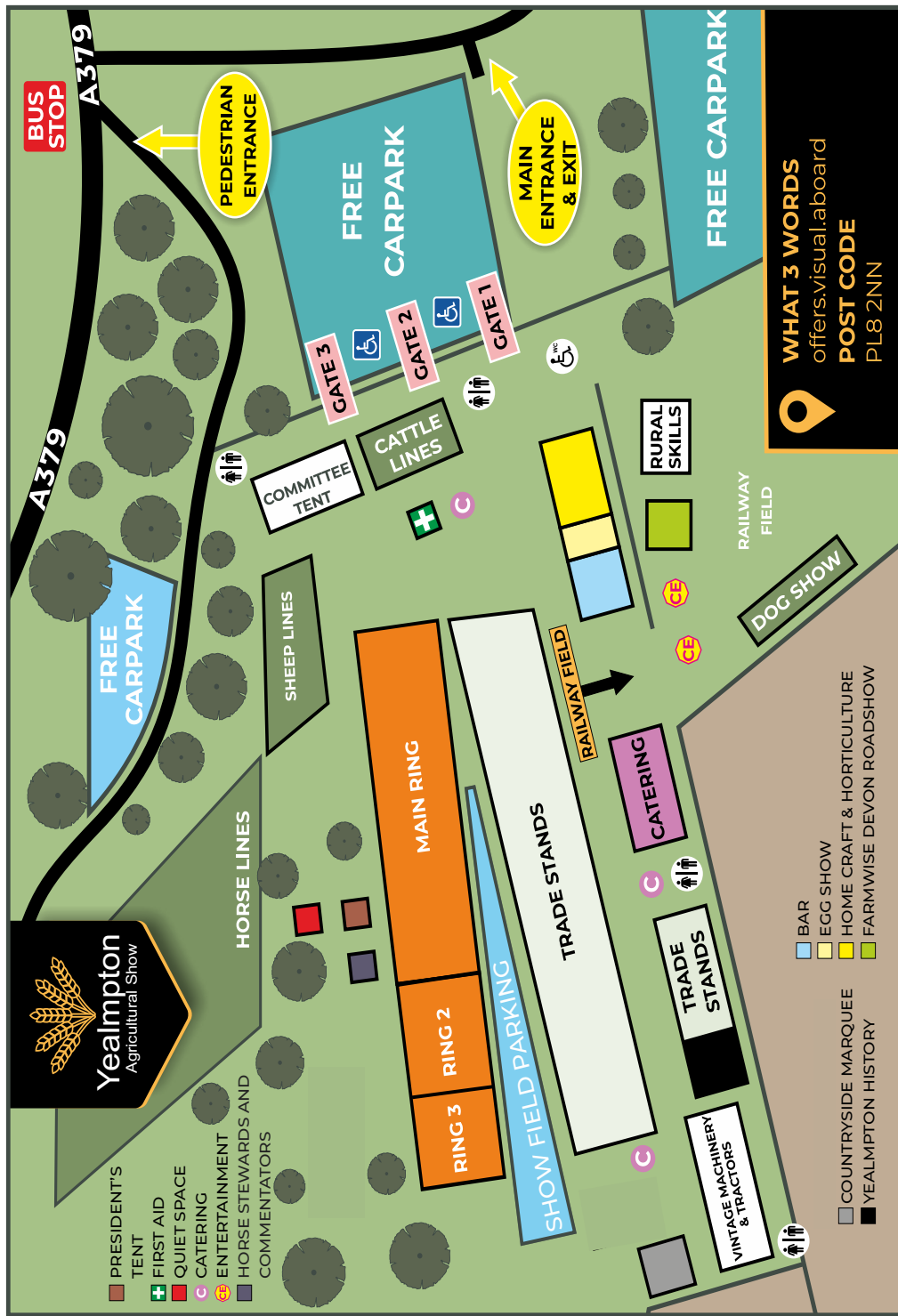

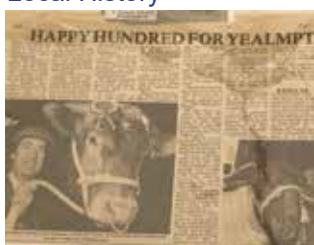

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Yealmlton Show Public Safety Notice

The organisers of the Yealmlton Show have made considerable efforts to ensure that your visit to the Show is as enjoyable & safe as possible. To assist us, though, we do ask you to do the following:-

1. Be alert to your surroundings.
2. Take care of your children by keeping them close to you and under your direct supervision.
3. Keep push chairs away from large animals as they may react to them.
4. If you lose your child, go to the Secretary's tent. If you find a child, stay where you are and send a message to the Secretary's tent.
5. Park your car as directed by the stewards and take care when walking to and from the showground through the car park. When reversing your car, do so carefully. The speed limit on the Show Ground at all times is 5 mph
6. Make yourself aware of the location of the First Aid point, next to the Secretary's tent.
7. Always keep your dogs on a lead and away from the livestock.
8. The Show takes place in fields so the ground may be uneven or slippery in wet conditions.
9. Be aware that there are guy ropes and pegs around marquees and tents so avoid coming into contact with them.
10. Drink plenty of water if the weather is hot and use sunscreen or sunblock. Take regular rests.
11. Listen to public announcements and advice from the Stewards. Follow any instructions that are given.
12. Please put your litter in the bins.
13. Stay well away from moving machinery and vehicles and do not tamper with them. Stay behind barriers or ropes when watching demonstrations and horse events.
14. Do not walk in the Animal Collecting Rings or the Show Rings.
15. Remember that all animals and birds can be unpredictable so treat them with care.
16. Wash your hands thoroughly before eating if you have been handling animals.
17. When entering marquees, take note of safety notices and exit signs.
18. Follow the safety advice when using the fairground rides.
19. Do not smoke in any of the marquees or tents.
20. Drink alcohol sensibly. Anti-social behaviour will not be tolerated and offenders may be removed from the Showground.
21. In an event of an emergency, please contact the nearest Steward who will deal with the problem.
22. If you hear a fire alarm/bell sounding, evacuate the area/marquee/tent and await instructions from a Steward or via the Public Address system.
23. Horses and ponies may only be ridden in the designated areas and not in areas open to the public.

Following prolonged dry weather, the grass may be more susceptible to fire.
Please take extra care with cigarettes, matches etc.

Notice to Exhibitors & Competitors

Exhibitors, traders and competitors must comply with the relevant Health and Safety regulations as well as the conditions of entry to the Show for traders and exhibitors.

Health & safety for all competitors, exhibitors and the general public

The organisers of the Yealmpton Agricultural Show will take all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, every-one present must themselves take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the Organisers and all Officials and Stewards. The organisers of the Show hereby give notice that they will accept no liability for injury to the person or any animal or for any loss or damage whatsoever suffered by any competitor or exhibitor in any horse-jumping or livestock competition or event. All such competitors and exhibitors take part at their own risk and before entering should inspect the course to satisfy themselves that the condition of the ground and construction of the fences are safe for competition.

EMERGENCIES

In the event of a major incident stewards report to the secretary's tent and liaise with the Director of the Yard and Safety Officer, or as directed by the P.A. system.

In an emergency, please contact the nearest show official who will address the problem.

In the event of a fire in a large marquee, a fire alarm (bell or horn) will warn occupants. The secretary must be informed immediately as well as the emergency services of any fire. (The emergency entrance for fire / ambulance is through the main entrance at Kitley Lodge gate and should be met at the lodge gate by a designated person to direct them to the incident.)

A FIRST AID POINT is adjacent to the Secretary's tent.

In the event that evacuation of the show ground is necessary follow the instructions given at the time either from the P.A. System or by a steward.

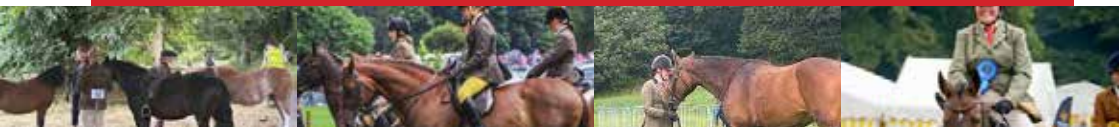

Show Ponies In Hand Ring 2

The NPS/Kalusta Stud British Riding Pony (Show Pony) In Hand Supreme National Championship.

To compete in Show Pony and Show Hunter Pony classes ponies must be registered in the NPS British Riding Pony Stud Book, Register, Appendix, International or Sports Pony section of the BRPSB, the GSB, the AHSB, the AASB or in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part-Breds are not eligible unless entered in the NPS British Riding Pony Stud Book, Register, Appendix, International or Sports Pony section of the BRPSB.

Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by adult NPS Qualifying or Life members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern August 2025. The highest placed pony, if owned by an NPS member, in each class will qualify for the final. Qualification may pass down to third place if the first and second ponies are already qualified.

A Long-Standing Devon Tradition

The Yealmpton Show stands as one of Devon's most enduring rural traditions, offering a vibrant window into the agricultural heritage of the South Hams. For generations, this cherished one-day event has brought together farmers, craftspeople, and families, anchoring the community with its steadfast scheduling rule: always held on the last Wednesday of July. Spanning over 130 years of history, the show has evolved from a modest exhibition of local livestock into a massive celebration of countryside life that attracts thousands of visitors annually.



The Kitley Estate Connection

The story of the Yealmpton Show is deeply intertwined with the historic Kitley Estate, the ancestral home of the Bastard family. For decades, the family has generously hosted the event on their picturesque parkland, providing a quintessential British backdrop of rolling green hills and ancient woodland. Under the long-standing guidance of figures like show president James “Spike” Bastard, the event has maintained its authentic, volunteer-led ethos. This deep connection to the land and its stewards has allowed the show to survive global upheavals, changing economic landscapes, and the shifting tides of modern entertainment, remaining a proud monument to Devon's farming identity.



Agricultural Excellence and Education

At its core, the Yealmpton Show has always been about agricultural excellence and education. In its earliest days, the primary focus was the competitive evaluation of livestock, where local farmers presented their finest cattle, sheep, and horses to be judged. Winning a rosette at Yealmpton was—and still is—a mark of immense pride and a testament to high-quality breeding. Alongside the livestock pens, horticultural marquees showcased the region's best produce, floral arrangements, and home crafts, celebrating the domestic skills that kept rural households thriving.



Rural Skills and Heritage Crafts

A central highlight of the modern show is the Rural Skills Marquee, which bridges generational gaps by offering an educational insight into rural life past and present. This dedicated space serves as a living classroom where the line between historical necessity and modern preservation blurs. Visitors can witness live demonstrations of heritage crafts that were once vital to everyday survival on Devonshire farms. Master craftsmen showcase the painstaking crafts of basket weaving, spinning, wood turning, and traditional lacemaking. These displays are not just historical reenactments; they illustrate how these ancient techniques have survived into the modern era, adapting to contemporary conservation, eco-friendly farming, and artisan markets. This interactive setting allows the public to understand how the foundational skills of yesterday continue to shape sustainable land management today.



Farmwise: Helping Children Understand Food

An increasingly important educational feature is Farmwise, which is directed especially at children and designed to help them understand where their food comes from. Through hands-on, sensory activities, young visitors are encouraged to connect the journey from field to fork, learning that milk, meat, fruit, vegetables, and everyday ingredients all begin with farming. By allowing children to see, touch, smell, and explore aspects of food production in a safe and engaging environment, Farmwise makes agricultural learning memorable, practical, and fun.



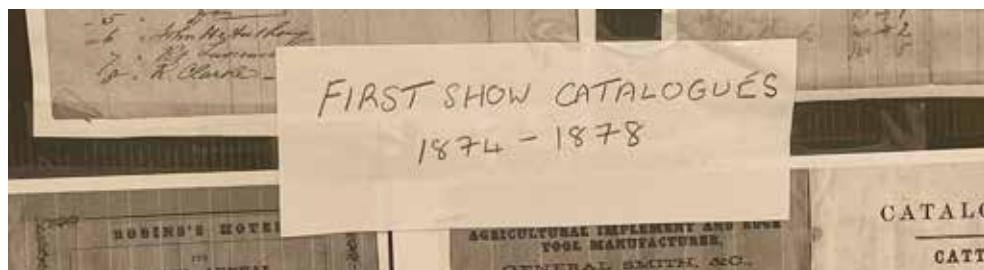
Modern Entertainment with Rustic Roots

Popular exhibits often highlight lost pieces of local history, such as the famous National Shire Horse Centre once located nearby, historic village fire brigades, and the fascinating stories of regional railways that were planned but never built. By Car

From Plymouth, take the A379 through Elburton and Brixton. On approaching Yealmpton, turn right immediately before Ben's Farm Shop entrance and follow the Show signs.

From Exeter and the A38. Leave the A38 Devon Expressway at the Smithaleigh Junction. Pass the filling station, and at the junction turn left, and left again. Follow this road for approximately 4 miles into the village of Yealmpton. At the junction, turn right onto the A379 towards Plymouth and proceed out of the village. Follow the show signs and turn left just after Ben's Farm Shop entrance.

Main Bus Routes

Stagecoach Service 3: This is the main, direct hourly connection. It runs between Plymouth (Royal Parade) and Kingsbridge / Dartmouth, passing directly through Plymstock, Elburton, and Brixton before dropping off at the Yealmpton Post Office or Stray Park stops.

Plymouth Citybus / Transport for South Hams Route 94: This local service links Plymouth to Yealmpton, Noss Mayo, and Newton Ferrers..
